Item 2 - Instructions to Bidders

By signing this proposal, a bidder acknowledges that he/she has a copy of the "Standard Specifications for Construction of Highways, Streets and Bridges", adopted by the Texas Department of Transportation, November 1, 2014. This specification book may be purchased from the Department.

<u>Item 3 – Award and Execution of Contract</u>

Material requests shall be issued by Work Order. Each Work Order shall specify items and quantities to be delivered as well as days to complete Work Order.

<u>Item 4 – Scope of Work</u>

In accordance with Special Provision 004-004 "Scope of Work (Materials Contract Only)", when mutually agreed upon in writing by both parties to the contract, the Engineer may extend the contract by change order, up to two times, for an additional period not to exceed the original contract time period.

The extended contract may be for additional quantities up to the original bid quantities, plus any quantities added by previously approved change orders.

The extension will meet the terms and conditions of the original contract, plus any approved terms and conditions made by previously approved change orders.

<u>Item 6 – Control of Materials</u>

Use materials from pre-qualified producers. A list of material producers pre-qualified by the Construction Division (CST) of the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) can be found at the following website:

<u>Item 8 - Prosecution and Progress</u>

Contract time charges shall begin upon issuance of "Authorization to Begin Work" letter. One hundred and twenty (120) Working Days have been designated for this contract. Working Days shall be computed and charged in accordance with Article 8.3.1.5 "Calendar Day."

Individual Work Order charge days shall run concurrently with Contract time charges.

In accordance with Article 8.6 "Failure to Complete Work on Time," liquidated damages shall be charged each day for failure to meet each work order. This will include:

1. Failure to produce at the starting date or continually progress on the work order.

- 2. Failure to produce the required amount of material per day.
- 3. Failure to complete work order within 3 weeks (21 calendar days) from the issue date on work order.

The amount assessed per day for liquidated damages shall be 1% of the estimated cost of the work order, not to be less than \$200 per day and not to exceed \$500 per day.

Notify the Maintenance Section Supervisor when encountering any unforeseen delays.

Item 9 – Measurement and Payment

In accordance with Article 9.2 "Plans Quantity Measurement," plans quantity measurement requirements are not applicable for this contract. Quantities shown in the plans are for bidding purposes only. TxDOT does not guarantee that all quantities shown in plans will be requested for delivery. Maintenance Sections may request quantities varying from those shown in the plans to meet their needs.

Contractor is responsible for obtaining annual overweight tolerance permit if hauling materials that exceed the legal road weight.

<u>Item 500 – Mobilization</u>

Mobilization does not apply to this Maintenance Materials Contract.

Item 502 – Barricades, Signs, and Traffic Handling

In accordance with Item 502.4.1.6, "Contracts with Callout Work and Work Orders", this item will not be paid for separately but will be considered subsidiary to the contract bid item.

Use strobe lights or rotation beacons on all motorized equipment operating on or adjacent to the road surface.

<u>Item 8016 Aggregates for Surface Treatment (Materials Only)</u>

There are 8 delivery site locations shown on the plans. Each location will represent a maintenance yard in the Amarillo District. Each delivery site location will have a separate bid item.

For the TY E aggregate, meet the requirements of TY B aggregate in Table 1 of Item 302. In addition, the dry loose unit weight of the TY E aggregate will be a

maximum of 60 pounds per cubic foot when tested in accordance with Tex-4014-A.

Provide aggregates for final surface that meet SACB. Crushed gravel, crushed slag, crushed stone, or LRA.

Minimum delivery quantity shall be 24 Tons/Cubic Yards.

Contact the receiving Maintenance Section Supervisor at least 24 hours prior to delivery.

Deliver Monday through Thursday during business hours only. Deliveries outside of these times may be allowed at the sole discretion of the Maintenance Section Supervisor.

The Contractors driver shall report to the Maintenance Section Supervisor, or his representative, at the time of arrival at the final delivery location and obtain a signature documenting the date and time of delivery and departure.
