



By signing this proposal, a bidder acknowledges that he/she has a copy of the "Standard Specifications for Construction of Highways, Streets and Bridges", adopted by the Texas Department of Transportation, November 1, 2014. This specification book may be purchased from the Department.

Item 3 – Award and Execution of Contract

Each contract awarded by the Department stands on its own and as such, is separate from other contracts. A contractor awarded multiple contracts, must be capable and sufficiently staffed to concurrently process any or all contracts at the same time.

Material requests shall be issued by Work Order. Each Work Order shall specify items and quantities to be delivered as well as days to complete Work Order.

Prior to beginning operations, the Department will arrange a preconstruction conference between representatives of the Department and the Contractor to discuss execution of the Contract.

Work orders will be scheduled and directed by the assigned TxDOT representative.

Item 4 – Scope of Work

This contract allows for two (2) extensions allowed by Special Provision 004-004 provided both the Contractor and TxDOT agree.

Item 6 – Control of Materials

Use materials from pre-qualified producers. A list of material producers pre-qualified by the

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Construction Division (CST) of the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) can be found at the following website: <https://www.txdot.gov/business/resources/producer-list.html>

Item 8 - Prosecution and Progress

Contract time charges shall begin upon issuance of “Authorization to Begin Work” letter. One hundred and eighty (180) Working Days have been designated for this contract. Working Days shall be computed and charged in accordance with Article 8.3.1.5 “Calendar Day.”

Individual Work Order charge days shall run concurrently with Contract time charges.

Contractor’s driver shall report to the State’s representative at the time of arrival at the final delivery location and obtain a signature documenting the date and time on the haul ticket which will include the Work Order number.

Notify the Maintenance Supervisor when encountering any unforeseen delays.

In accordance with Article 8.6 “Failure to Complete Work on Time,” liquidated damages shall be charged for failure to complete each Work Order in 7 calendar days. The amount assessed per day for liquidated damages shall be 5% of the estimated cost of the Work Order, not to be less than \$250 per day and not to exceed \$1000 per day.

Item 9 – Measurement and Payment

In accordance with Article 9.2 “Plans Quantity Measurement,” plans quantity measurement requirements are not applicable for this contract. Quantities shown in the plans are for bidding purposes only. TxDOT does not guarantee that all quantities shown in plans will be requested for delivery.

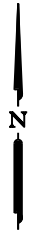
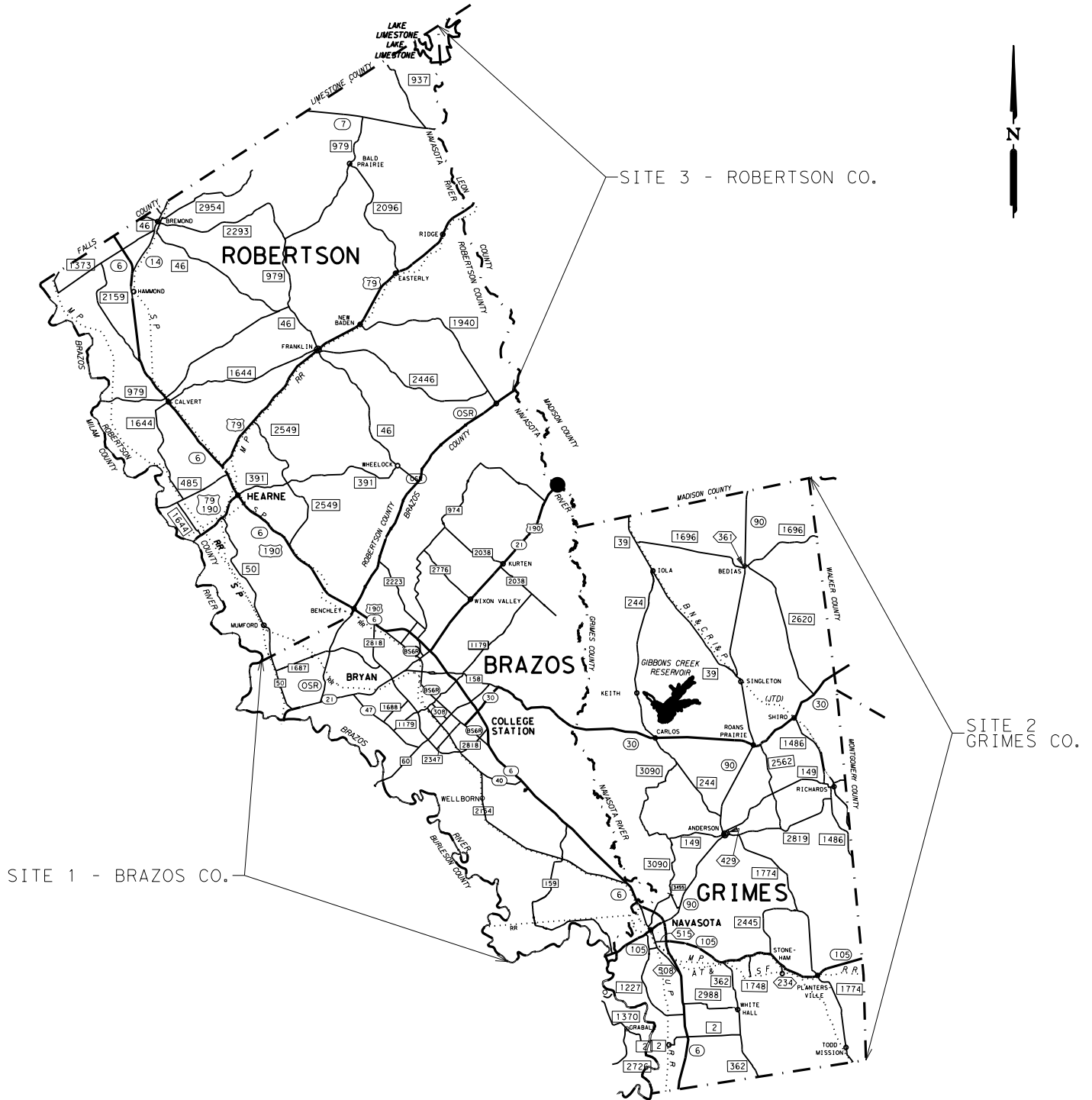
Item 8010 – Emulsion

Minimum delivery quantity shall be 4,000 gallons.

Transport truck shall be equipped with transfer pump and required hoses to transfer material from transport to TxDOT storage tanks. Hose shall be compatible with 3-inch cam lock type connection.

Failure to provide required pump and hoses may result in rejection of the transported load.
