

GENERAL NOTES:

General:

The intent of this contract is to provide materials (bulk salt) at non-site specific locations within the Atlanta District. The contractor will provide materials delivered to a designated location as defined in the contract and as specified in the Work Order.

Provide and maintain a dedicated email address for receipt of work orders and correspondence throughout the term of this contract. Acknowledgement of emailed work order/callouts is required no more than 12 hr. from notification

Each contract awarded by the Department stands on its own and as such, is separate from other contracts. A Contractor awarded multiple contracts must be capable and sufficiently staffed to concurrently process any or all contracts.

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Prior to beginning operations, the Department will arrange a preconstruction conference between representatives of the Department and the Contractor. In this meeting, the representatives from all parties will discuss the contract, proposed procedures and the plans for performing the work while providing for safe passage of traffic at all times. Specifications, unusual conditions, and other pertinent items regarding the work will also be discussed.

Limit the use of the roadway for the hauling of material to legal loads. Keep the traveled surfaces used in hauling operations free of dirt or other materials.

Department-approved safety hats and safety vests will be worn by all workers and visitors when:

Workers are outside of vehicles at all outdoor worksites. This includes those who occasionally visit worksites either on the highway surface or right-of-way.

Working in areas where there is a danger of head injury from impact, from falling or flying objects, or from electrical shock or burns.

Non-compliance with this requirement will be grounds for suspension of work.

Item 8: Prosecution and Progress

Time charges will be in accordance with Article 8.3.1.5 “Calendar Day”.

In accordance with Article 8.6 “Failure to Complete Work on Time,” liquidated damages will be charged for failure to complete each Work Order as specified. The amount assessed per day for liquidated damages will be 5% of the estimated cost of the Work Order, but not to be less than \$250 per day and not to exceed \$1000 per day.

Time requirements for each of the Work Orders will be indicated on each individual Work Order. Contractor will be given no less than 3 days’ notice for bulk salt delivery to successfully complete each Work Order.

Notify the Maintenance Supervisor when encountering any unforeseen delays.

Item 9: Measurement & Payment

In accordance with Article 9.1, “Measurement of Quantities,” furnish the tare and maximum gross weights as well as the volume capacity of all vehicles, trucks, truck-tractors, trailers, semi-trailers, or combination of such vehicles used to deliver materials for the contract. Also, furnish calculations supporting these weights and capacities. Provide all measurements required for pay a minimum of 2 days before the equipment is used.

In accordance with Article 9.2 “Plans Quantity Measurement,” plans quantity measurement requirements are not applicable for this contract.

Contractor is responsible for obtaining annual overweight tolerance permit if hauling material which exceeds the legal road weight.

In addition to the complete destination address, each delivery ticket must be clearly marked with the work order number. Each shipment must be accompanied by a haul ticket.

Contractor’s driver shall report to the State’s representative at the time of arrival at the final delivery location and obtain a signature documenting the date and time.

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When material is measured by the ton, provide a conversion rate to cubic yards on each haul ticket

The minimum call out per work will be 20 tons.

Item 500: Mobilization

Mobilization does not apply to this non-site specific materials contract.

Item 502: Barricades, Signs and Traffic Handling

TxDOT will provide any traffic control needed.

Use strobe lights or rotating beacons on all motorized equipment, operating on or adjacent to the road surface.

Item 8032: Winter Weather Materials (Materials Only)

Deliver Type I road salt in bulk or in 1 ton totes (supersacs).

Deliver Type II brine salt in bulk or in 1 ton totes (supersacs).

Measurement and payment will be by the ton.

Deliver materials as identified on the call-out work order. Delivery Site locations are defined below.

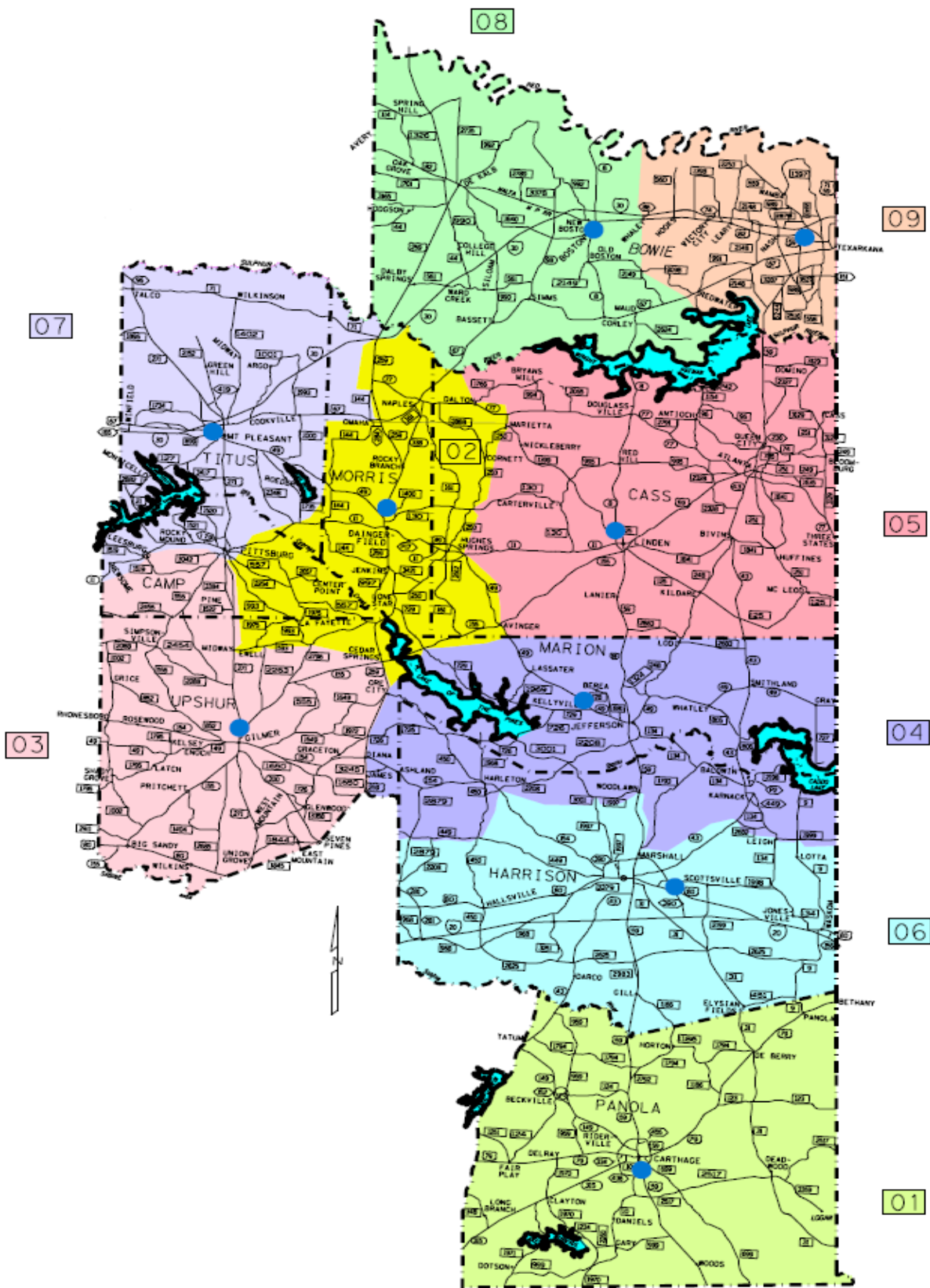
