Working days will be computed and charged in accordance with Section 8.3.1.5., "Calendar Day."

In accordance with Article 8.6 "Failure to Complete Work on Time," Liquidated damages will be charged for failure to complete each Work Order as specified. The amount assessed per day for liquidated damages will be 5% of the estimated cost of the Work Order, but not to be less than \$250 per day and not to exceed \$1000 per day.

Time requirements for each of the Work Orders will be indicated on each individual Work Order. Contractor will be given no less than 24 hours' notice for hot mix (pick up) and 48 hours' notice for hot mix (delivery) to successfully complete each Work Order.
