

By signing this proposal, a bidder acknowledges that he/she has a copy of the “Standard Specifications for Construction of Highways, Streets and Bridges”, adopted by the Texas Department of Transportation, November 1, 2014. This specification book may be purchased from the Department.

**Item 3 – Award and Execution of Contract**

Each contract awarded by the Department stands on its own and as such, is separate from other contracts. If the Contractor awarded multiple contracts, they must be sufficiently equipped, possess or acquire the necessary materials and be sufficiently staffed to concurrently process all contracts at the same time.

Material requests shall be issued by Work Order. Each Work Order shall specify items and quantities to be delivered as well as days to complete Work Order.

Prior to beginning operations, the Department will arrange a preconstruction conference between representatives of the Department and the Contractor to discuss execution of the Contract.

Work orders will be scheduled and directed by the assigned TxDOT representative.

**Item 4 – Scope of Work**

This contract allows for two (2) extensions allowed by Special Provision 004-004 provided both the Contractor and TxDOT agree.

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**Item 6 – Control of Materials**

Use materials from pre-qualified producers. A list of material producers pre-qualified by the Construction Division (CST) of the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) can be found at the following website: <https://www.txdot.gov/business/resources/producer-list.html>

**Item 8 - Prosecution and Progress**

Contract time charges shall begin upon issuance of “Authorization to Begin Work” letter. One hundred and twenty (120) Working Days have been designated for this contract. Working Days shall be computed and charged in accordance with Article 8.3.1.5 “Calendar Day.”

Individual Work Order charge days shall run concurrently with Contract time charges.

Contractor’s driver shall report to the State’s representative at the time of arrival at the final delivery location and obtain a signature documenting the date and time on the haul ticket which will include the Work Order number.

Notify the Maintenance Supervisor when encountering any unforeseen delays.

In accordance with Article 8.6 “Failure to Complete Work on Time,” liquidated damages shall be charged for failure to complete each Work Order in 7 calendar days.

**Item 9 – Measurement and Payment**

In accordance with Article 9.2 “Plans Quantity Measurement,” plans quantity measurement requirements are not applicable for this contract. Quantities shown in the plans are for bidding purposes only. TxDOT does not guarantee that all quantities shown in plans will be requested for delivery.

The acceptance of this contract does not guarantee that any materials may be purchased (zero-run) by TXDOT during the time period for which the contract is active.

Material quantities less or more than those listed in the contract estimate (under-run / over-run) may be requested based upon TXDOT needs and requirements and shall be provided at the same cost per unit of measure as per the original bid price.

**Item 8012 – Hydraulic Cement (Materials Only)**

There are 3 delivery site locations as shown in “General Requirements and Covenants – Items 1 thru 9” of these General Notes. Each location will represent a maintenance section in the Bryan

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District. Each delivery site location will have its own unique bid item.

Minimum delivery quantity shall be 25 tons for Hydraulic Cement (Bulk) and/or 896 bags of Hydraulic Cement (47 lbs. bag). Partial loads will use multiplier to cover full load freight cost.

Contact the receiving Maintenance Section Supervisor at least 24 hours prior to delivery.

Deliver Monday through Thursday during business hours only. Deliveries outside of these times must be approved by the Maintenance Section Supervisor or their representative prior to delivery.
