All questions submitted that generate a response will be posted through this site. The site is organized by District, Project Type (Construction or Maintenance), Letting Date, CCSJ/Project Name.

The Maintenance Supervisor for Matagorda County is Michael Jasek @ 979-244-6943.

The Maintenance Supervisor will make arrangements with the Contractor to have the material delivered.

The contractor is responsible for furnishing and delivering the dense-graded hot-mix asphalt to the Matagorda Maintenance Yard. The delivery hours will be Monday through Thursday 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM. The Maintenance Section will stockpile the material.

Furnish a certified copy of the legal gross weight of each vehicle hauling materials by weight and certified measurements for all trucks hauling material by volume.

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ITEM 4: SCOPE OF WORK

If agreed upon in writing by both parties to the contract, the contract may be extended for an additional period of time not to exceed the original contract time period. The extended contract may be for additional quantities up to the original bid quantities plus any quantities added by an approved change order. The extensions shall meet the terms and conditions of the original contract plus any approved terms and conditions made by previously approved change orders.

ITEM 8011: DENSE-GRADED HOT-MIX ASPHALT (SMALL QUANTITY) (MATERIALS ONLY)

Mixture designs, without additives, failing to meet the requirements of Table 6 will require the addition of a minimum 1.0% of Type A hydrated lime based on dry weight of the total aggregate.

Use of RAS in the HMA surface course is not permitted.

Do not add additional quantity of RAP to stockpiles tested and approved. If additional RAP is added to a stockpile, a new design and trial batch will be required prior to placement on the roadway.

The extracted aggregate from contractor-owned RAP shall have a minimum of 85% two crushed faces when tested in accordance with TEX-460-A, Part I.

Deliver Hot Mix to the roadway in belly dumps unless otherwise directed by the Maintenance Supervisor.

There will usually be two rounds of material delivered each day. Schedule the trucking so that all the trucks ordered for each round of trucks arrive at the site around the same time. No truck will be dumped and allowed to leave the construction site until all the trucks ordered for that round have arrived on the site.
