Contractor shall provide and maintain a dedicated email address for receipt of work orders and correspondence throughout the term of the contract. Response to all correspondence shall be made within 1 business day.

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Each contract awarded by the Department stands on its own and as such, is separate from other contracts. A Contractor awarded multiple contracts must be capable and sufficiently staffed to concurrently process any or all contracts.

Prior to beginning operations, the Department will arrange a preconstruction conference between representatives of the Department and the Contractor. In this meeting, the representatives from all parties will discuss the contract, proposed procedures and the plans for performing the work while providing for safe passage of traffic at all times. Specifications, unusual conditions, and other pertinent items regarding the work will also be discussed.

Limit the use of the roadway for the hauling of material to legal loads. Keep the traveled surface used in hauling operations free of dirt or other materials.

Department-approved safety hats and safety vests will be worn by all workers and visitors when:

Workers are outside of the vehicles at all outdoor worksites. This includes those who occasionally visit worksites either on the highway surface or right-of-way.

Working in areas where there is a danger of head injury from impact, from falling or flying objects, or from electrical shock or burns.

Non-compliance with this requirement will be grounds for suspension of work.

ITEM 3. AWARD AND EXECUTION OF CONTRACT

Material requests shall be issued by Work Order. Each Work Order shall specify items and quantities to be delivered as well as a time frame to complete the Work Order.

ITEM 8. PROSECUTION AND PROGRESS

Working days will be computed and charged in accordance with Section 8.3.1.5., “Calendar Day.”

In accordance with Article 8.6 “Failure to Complete Work on Time,” Liquidated damages will be charged for failure to complete each Work Order as specified. The amount assessed per day for liquidated damages will be 5% of the estimated cost of the Work Order, but not to be less than \$250 per day and not to exceed \$1000 per day.

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Time requirements for each of the Work Orders will be indicated on each individual Work Order. Contractor will be given no less than 48 hours' notice for delivery to successfully complete each Work Order.

Notify the Project Manager when encountering any unforeseen delays.

ITEM 9. MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT

In accordance with Article 9.2 "Plans Quantity Measurement", plans quantity measurement requirements are not applicable for this contract. Project Manager may request quantities varying from those shown in the plans to meet their needs.

Contractor is responsible for obtaining annual over weight tolerance permit if hauling materials that exceed the legal road weight.

ITEM 500. MOBILIZATION

Mobilization does not apply to this materials contract.

ITEM 502. BARRICADES, SIGNS, AND TRAFFIC HANDLING

TxDOT will provide any traffic control needs.

Use strobe lights or rotating beacons on all motorized equipment, operating on or adjacent to the road surface.

ITEM 8032. WINTER WEATHER MATERIALS (MATERIALS ONLY)

Item 8032 – This contract is for Complex Chloride that meets the specification of TxDOT SS 8032 to be used as a winter weather material product and shall conform to DMS-6400.

Delivery will be Monday through Friday during business hours only, unless other arrangements have been requested and agreed upon by the Project Manager or his delegate.

Material will be delivered by super sacks or by the 50# bags on pallets, whichever is specified on the work order by the Project Manager or his delegate.

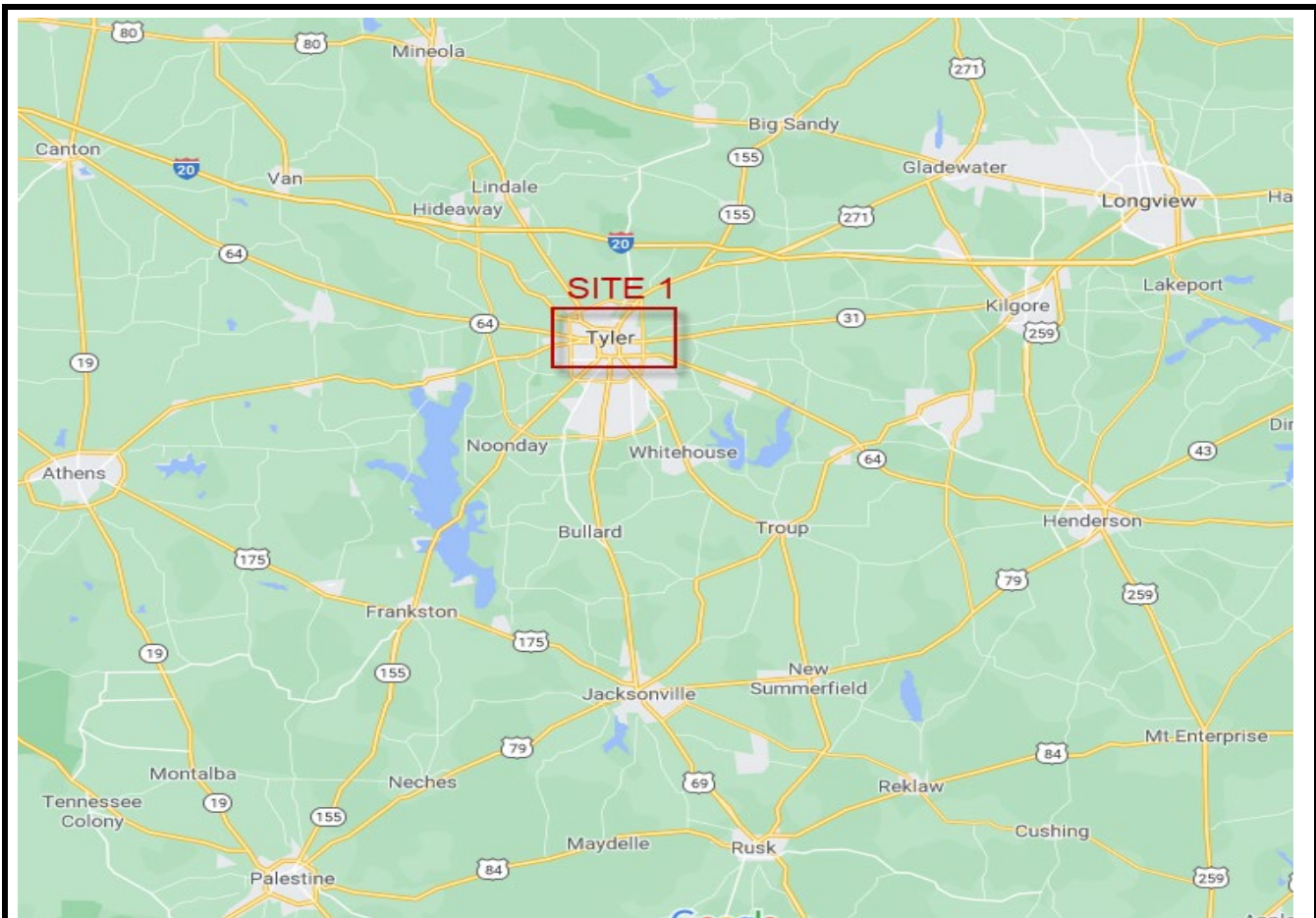
A work order will be issued to the contractor a minimum of 48 hours in advance of date needed for delivery. All orders will be in full truck load increments. A full truck load being defined as the maximum legal gross weight of 80,000 pounds on Texas Highways without a permit.
