By signing this proposal, a bidder acknowledges that they have a copy of the “Standard Specifications for Construction of Highways, Streets and Bridges”, adopted by the Texas Department of Transportation, November 1, 2014. This specification book may be purchased from the Department.

ITEM 3 – AWARD AND EXECUTION OF CONTRACT:

Each contract awarded by the Department stands on its own and as such, is separate from other contracts. A contractor awarded multiple contracts, must be capable and sufficiently staffed to concurrently process any or all contracts at the same time.

Material requests shall be issued by Work Order. Each Work Order shall be scheduled by the assigned TXDOT representative and will specify items, quantities, and delivery location.

Each Work Order sent by the Department is independent and separate from other Work Orders held by the Contractor. If the Contractor is sent multiple Work Orders, they must be equipped to provide, possess, or acquire the necessary material and be sufficiently staffed to fulfill all Work Orders at the same time.

Prior to beginning operations, the Department will arrange a preconstruction conference between representatives of the Department and the Contractor to discuss execution of the Contract.

From the time a Regular (non-expedited) Work Order is issued, Contractor has fourteen (14) calendar days to deliver materials; Expedited Material Request (EMR) Work Orders shall be required to be delivered within twenty-four (24) hours of receiving the EMR Work Order.

The Contractor shall provide and maintain a dedicated email address for receipt of work orders and correspondence throughout the term of this contract. Acknowledgement of emailed work orders / callouts is required to be sent no later than 12 hours from notification. Additionally,

provide at least two phone contact numbers with individuals who are authorized and responsible to enact EMR Work Orders.

ITEM 4 – SCOPE OF WORK:

This contract allows for two (2) four-month extensions as allowed by Special Provision 004-004 provided both the Contractor and TXDOT agree.

ITEM 6 – CONTROL OF MATERIALS:

Contractor shall furnish all material in accordance with applicable specifications, test methods and general notes in this Contract and as directed by the Engineer.

ITEM 8 – PROSECUTION AND PROGRESS:

Contract time charges shall begin upon issuance of “Authorization to Begin Work” letter. This Contract is for one-hundred and twenty (120) days and shall be computed and charged in accordance with Article 8.3.1.5 “Calendar Day.”

Individual Work Order charge days shall run concurrently with Contract time charges.

The delivery hours will be Monday through Thursday from 7:00AM to 5:00PM.

Contractor’s driver shall report to the State’s representative at the time of arrival at the final delivery location and obtain a signature documenting the date and time on the haul ticket which will include the Work Order number.

Notify the Maintenance Supervisor when encountering any unforeseen delays.

From the time a Work Order is issued, Contractor will have the number of days specified in ITEM 3 for the type of Work Order (Regular or EMR) to deliver requested materials. After that time period, in accordance with Article 8.6 “Failure to Complete Work on Time,” liquidated damages shall be charged for each day the Contractor fails to complete delivery on each Work Order unless approved by the Engineer in writing.

ITEM 9 – MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT:

In accordance with Article 9.2 “Plans Quantity Measurement,” plans quantity measurement requirements are not applicable for this contract. Quantities shown in the plans are for bidding purposes only.

TXDOT does not guarantee that all or only the quantities shown in plans for delivery may be requested (under-run / over-run). Contractor should expect to provide materials in the quantity and type requested in the Work Order(s). Material quantities less or more than those listed in the contract estimate (under-run / over-run) may be requested based upon TXDOT needs and requirements and shall be provided at the same cost per unit of measure as per the original bid price.

The acceptance of this contract also does not guarantee that any materials may be purchased (zero-run) by TXDOT during the time period for which the contract is active.

Contractor is responsible for obtaining annual overweight tolerance permit if hauling material which exceeds the legal road weight.

Item 8032 – Winter Weather Material (Materials Only)

Washington Co. (Site 1), Burleson Co. (Site 2), and Milam Co. (Site 3) will take delivery of TY-II Brine Salt in Supersack bags. Work Order minimum delivery will be sixteen (16) bags to any location.

Emergency Operations - Washington Co. (Site 1-EMR), Burleson Co. (Site 2-EMR), and Milam Co. (Site 3-EMR) will take delivery of TY-II Brine Salt in Supersack bags. Work Order minimum delivery will be sixteen (16) bags to any location.

Delivery cost is subsidiary to Item 8032 materials noted in this Contract.

Type II Brine Salt shall be clean and free of debris.

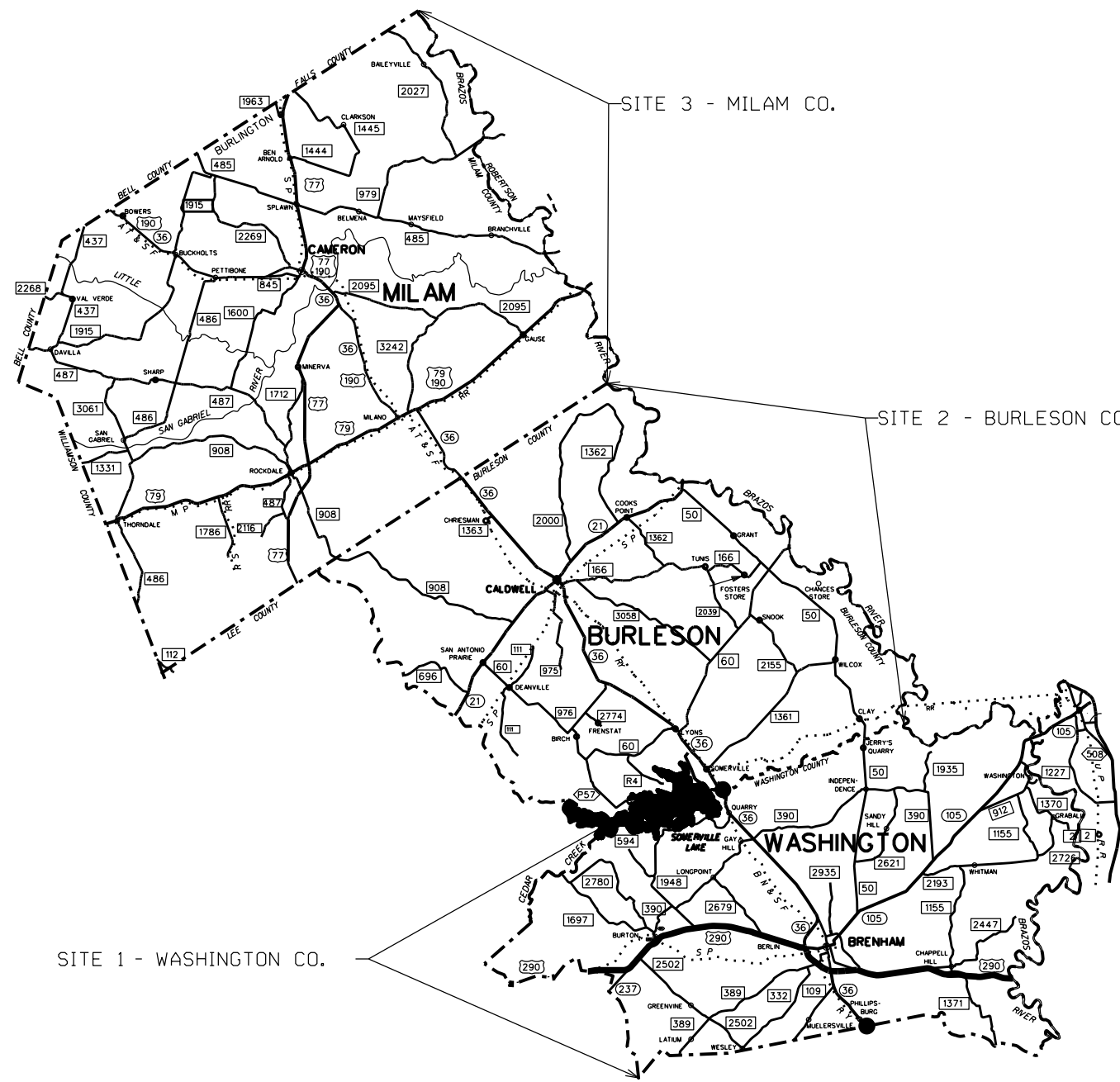
