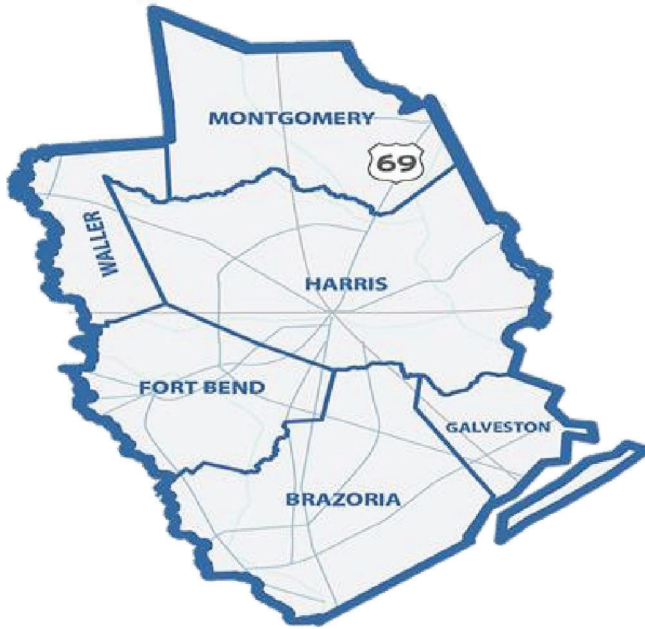

GENERAL NOTES

General:

The purpose of this contract is to supply Winter Weather Materials for the Houston District at the following locations:

Site 1: Delivery location will be within the Houston District as directed by Work Order and Managing Office.

The Contractor will provide materials to TxDOT by the following methods:

Method A: The Contractor will deliver the materials to TxDOT maintenance yards or locations within the Houston District.

Each contract awarded by the Department stands on its own as such, is separate from other contracts. A Contractor awarded multiple contracts, must be capable and sufficiently staffed to concurrently process any or all contracts at the same time.

Section 10.4: Control of the Work

Prior to beginning operations, the Department will arrange a coordination call between representatives of the Department and Contractor. In this meeting, the representatives from all parties will discuss the Contract, proposed procedures, and plans for performing the work while providing safe passage for traffic at all times. Specifications, unusual conditions, and other pertinent items regarding the work will also be discussed. Limit the use of the roadway for the hauling of material to legal roads. Keep the traveled surfaces used in hauling operations free of dirt or other materials.

In accordance with article 10.4.3.1, this contract may be extended twice not to exceed 360 calendar days for the entire contract term if mutually agreed.

Section 10.8: Prosecution and Progress

There are 365 calendar days on this contract. Calendar days will be charged in accordance with Article 10.8.2., "Contract Term".

Types of accepted haul vehicles include belly dump and end dump trucks.

Each work order will specify a delivery site by the bid item in the contract and quantity to be supplied. The minimum amount of material to be ordered on an individual work order is twenty-five (25) tons or one (1) truck load. There are 7 working days allowed to complete each work order. For this contract the delivery site or delivery site 1 may be any location located within the Houston District or as directed by the managing office.
