

All questions submitted that generate a response will be posted through this site. The site is organized by District, Project Type (Construction or Maintenance), Letting Date, and CCSJ/Project Name.

Each contract awarded by the Department stands on its own and as such, is separate from other contracts. A Contractor awarded multiple contracts must be capable and sufficiently staffed to concurrently process any or all contracts.

This project consists of the purchase of Wrong Way Driver (WWD) detection equipment delivered to the TransGuide office at 3500 NW Loop 410. All work on this contract will be scheduled and directed by the following:

ITEM 8

Contract time charges shall be in accordance with Article 8.3.1.5 "Calendar Day".

Contract time charges shall begin 7 calendar days after issuance of "Authorization to Begin Work" letter, or the date work occurs if within those 7 calendar days, and will continue for 120

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calendar days, with up to two 120 calendar day renewals in accordance with the Special Provision 004-004 "Scope of Work (Materials Contract Only)".

All work on this contract will be issued by individual work order via email. Provide and maintain a dedicated email address for receipt of work orders and correspondence throughout the term of this contract.

Work order will include at a minimum the starting delivery date when individual work order charge days begin, number of working days allowed for the work order, the delivery location, bid item, and quantity of material to deliver.

Work order charge days shall be in accordance with 8.3.1.5 "Calendar Day" and shall run concurrently with contract time charges.

In accordance with Article 8.6 "Failure to Complete Work on Time," liquidated damages shall be charged for failure to complete each work order within the specified number of days.

The amount assessed per day for liquidated damages will be 5% of the estimated cost of the work order, but not to be less than \$250 per day and not to exceed \$1,000 per day.

ITEM 9

In accordance with Article 9.2 "Plans Quantity Measurement," plans quantity measurement requirements are not applicable for this contract. Quantities shown in the plans are for bidding purposes only. TxDOT does not guarantee that all quantities shown in the plans will be requested for delivery.

Deliveries of material on this Contract will be made to the TxDOT TransGuide office located at: 3500 NW Loop 410, San Antonio, TX 78229.

Contact the TransGuide Operations Manager, John Gianotti at (210) 415-0688, at least 48 hours prior to delivery.

Deliver material during TxDOT business hours only – M-F, 8 am to 5 pm. Deliveries outside of these times will not be allowed, unless approved in advance by the TransGuide Operations Manager.

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The Contractor's driver shall report to the TransGuide Operations Manager, or his representative, at the time of arrival at the final delivery location and obtain a signature documenting the date and time of delivery.

The quantity of "Each" for this item is a system comprised of several different pieces of equipment. These components work together to create the system that is used to detect a wrong way driver. The plans for the TxDOT construction project CSJ 0017-02-080 detail the type and quantity of each specific piece of equipment required at each of the 18 exit ramp locations on IH 35. Contact the TransGuide Operations Manager – John.Gianotti@txdot.gov to obtain a copy of the construction plans that contain the specific details of the type and quantities of the equipment needed at each location.
