

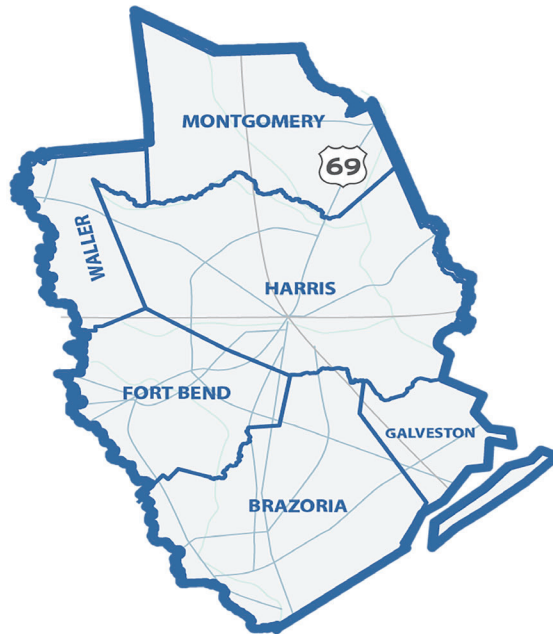

GENERAL NOTES

General:

The purpose of this contract is to supply Pothole Patching Materials for the Houston District at the following locations:

Delivery location will be within the Houston District as directed by Work Order and the Managing Office.

The Contractor will provide materials to TxDOT by the following methods:

Method A: The Contractor will deliver the materials to TxDOT maintenance yards or locations within the Houston District.

Method B: TxDOT will pick up the materials from the Contractor's yard/plant that will be loaded into TxDOT owned trucks or trucks owned by others working with or for TxDOT. Load material into TxDOT equipment at time of pickup.

Each contract awarded by the Department stands on its own as such, is separate from other contracts. A Contractor awarded multiple contracts, must be capable and sufficiently staffed to concurrently process any or all contracts at the same time.

Section 10.4: Control of the Work

Prior to beginning operations, the Department will arrange a coordination call between representatives of the Department and Contractor. In this meeting, the representatives from all parties will discuss the Contract, proposed procedures, and plans for performing the work while providing safe passage for traffic at all times. Specifications, unusual conditions, and other pertinent items regarding the work will also be discussed. Limit the use of the roadway for the hauling of material to legal roads. Keep the traveled surfaces used in hauling operations free of dirt or other materials.

In accordance with article 10.4.3.1, this contract may be extended once not to exceed 365 calendar days for the entire contract term if mutually agreed.

Section 10.8: Prosecution and Progress

There are 366 calendar days on this contract. Calendar days will be charged in accordance with Article 10.8.2., "Contract Term".

Types of accepted haul vehicles include belly dump and end dump trucks.

Each work order will specify a delivery site by the bid item in the contract and quantity to be supplied. The minimum amount of material to be ordered on an individual work order is twenty-five (25) tons or one (1) truck load. There are 7 working days allowed to complete each work order.

All work on this contract will be issued by Work Order via email. A work order will include the bid item, material, quantity; the number of days allowed and associated liquidated damages for failure to provide the materials within the specified number of days. In addition, the Work Order must also include how the materials will be provided to TxDOT. If the material is to be delivered to TxDOT, the work order must include the location and TxDOT's point of contact for delivery.

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The Contractor will provide a dedicated email address for processing Work Orders and is required to acknowledge by responding to each Work Order request to confirm receipt within 1 business day. Time charges will begin within 2 business days if no confirmation is received by TxDOT.

Item 8043: Asphaltic Concrete Patching Material

The minimum quantity of material ordered per Work Order on this contract is 25 TON.

For all deliveries use end dump truck or as directed.

Coordinate with the designated TxDOT point of contact at least 24 hours prior to delivery.



ELECTRONIC RECORD AND SIGNATURE DISCLOSURE

From time to time, Texas Department of Transportation (we, us or Company) may be required by law to provide to you certain written notices or disclosures.
